

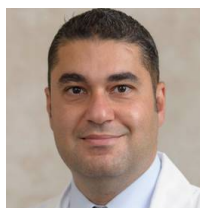

**Peter Grinspoon, MD**, is a primary care physician at Massachusetts General Hospital and an Instructor at Harvard Medical School. He is a board member of the advocacy group Doctors For Cannabis Regulation. He has been on national television including NBC, C-SPAN and Fox and Friends and Fox Nation discussing cannabis and the opioid crisis; he has been quoted in the national press such as *People* magazine, *The Washington Post*, *The Boston Globe*, and *New York Magazine*; and his writing has been published in *The Nation* and *The Los Angeles Times*.



**Shannon Scott-Vernaglia, MD**, is the Pediatrics Residency Program Director at the MassGeneral Hospital for Children and an Assistant Professor at Harvard Medical School. Dr. Scott-Vernaglia maintains an active primary care practice at the MGH Pediatric Group Practice and she actively teaches as an outpatient preceptor for residents, medical and nurse practitioner students. She is passionate about physician mental health and decreasing stigma associated with mental illness among clinicians and was proud to publish a personal narrative "One of the Many" in *JGME* in June 2019.



**Simon G. Talbot, MD**, is an Associate Professor of Surgery at Harvard Medical School and Attending Surgeon in the Division of Plastic Surgery at Brigham and Women's Hospital (BWH), Boston, Massachusetts. He is heavily involved in the area of physician distress, burnout, and moral injury, with a leading article in *Stat News* being downloaded more than 280000 times, and frequently speaking and consulting nationally on this topic.
